Sina Morrissey, Development Specialist at Neighborhood House of Milwaukee spoke to our club about the history and mission of her organization. Founded in 1945 by Father Reinhart Gutmannuse, the Neighborhood House of MKE works to build a strong community by strengthening individuals and families.

Neighborhood House goals align with major community initiatives aimed at helping people of all ages combat the devastating effects of poverty, including: 1.) Educational preparedness; 2) Academic engagement and achievement; 3) Access to post-secondary opportunities; and 4.) Family engagement

A safe and nurturing place for urban youth, families and seniors, Neighborhood House has grown into a modern, 60,000 square-foot facility that has served more than a third million children and adults – providing accredited child care, pre-school, programs for kids, teens, families, refugees, and elders. Neighborhood House hosts summer camps, senior game days, field trips, computer lab lessons, art and cooking classes, gardening and literacy services to refugees, primarily Southeast Asian & African families.
