Reasons to love Rotary right now Reasons #36: Rotary is a Strong Supporter of Youth Programs

Rotary's programs are developing the next generation of leaders, providing funding to make the world a better place, and making peace a priority. For example, Rotary Youth Exchange builds peace one young person at a time.

Students learn a new language, discover another culture, and truly become global citizens - making long lasting friends. Exchanges for students 15 to 19 years old are sponsored by Rotary clubs in more than 100 countries.

Long-term exchanges last a full academic year – with students attending local schools and living with multiple host families. Short-term exchanges last from several days to three months - as structured as camps, tours, or homestays.

Week of May 4th - Dave Bandomir, Mobile Integrated Healthcare / Pulse Point CPR

Dave Bandomir, West Allis Fire Dept, explained the Mobile Intergrated Healthcare they conduct in the community. Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA) is a leading cause of death in the US, accounting for nearly 1,000 deaths per day. Survival rates nationally are less than 8%.

Delivery of CPR can sustain life until paramedics arrive by helping maintain vital blood flow to the heart and brain but only about a third of SCA victims receive bystander CPR. Because permanent brain damage or death can occur in as little as 8 minutes, effective bystander CPR, provided immediately, can double or triple a person's chance of survival.

When a cardiac emergency strikes, finding an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) can help save a Life - but only if you know where one is located. PulsePoint tracks locations so that emergency responders, including nearby citizens trained in CPR and off-duty professionals (firefighters, police officers, nurses, etc.), can find an AED close by. The West Allis Rotary helped sponsor two, local AEDs including one at the farmer's market!
