Last Week: May 24th – Guatemala Medical Resource Partnership (GMRP)



The Guatemala Medical Resource Partnership is a Wisconsin Rotary project that helps bridge the gap in medical services for the people of Guatemala. This mission was founded in 2003 with the vision of Wisconsin Rotarian, Doug Hanson. Positioned in Oliveros, Santa Rosa, Guatemala a team of around 40 to 50 individuals travel to offer a clinic with General Medical, Vision and Dental care.

An elementary school shuts down for one week to allow the different class rooms to be set up as a



pharmacy, dental area, medical rooms for kids and adults and a room for fitting reading and sun glasses. An advance team sets up the equipment, tables and chairs before the main group comes down. GMRP is always seeking medical, dental and vision professionals who could offer their talents and services to the mission. The mission is also in need of interpreters, bilingual nutri-tionists and other team members.

Richard Muirhead served in the Peace Corps in Peru from 1966 to 1969. Since his Peace Corps service ended, Richard has traveled to Latin America annually. He has taught in Mexico, Ecuador, Peru, and Argentina. He recently retired from his position as Director of

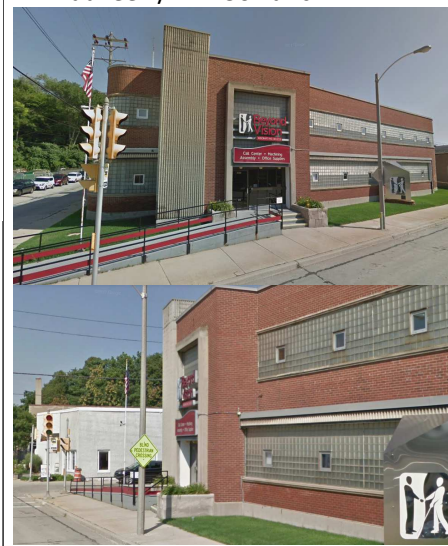
International Studies at Mount Mary University in Milwaukee. He is also actively involved with Global Partners: Running Waters
