The 109th annual international Rotary convention will take place in Toronto on June 23–27, and is expected to bring 24,000 Rotary club members from over 175 countries.

- The population of the City of Toronto is 2.8 million, ranking fourth in North America, behind Mexico City, New York City and Los Angeles, and just slightly ahead of Chicago.
- Famous for its diversity, Toronto may be the world's most global city, with 50 percent of the population born outside of Canada.
- Some 130 languages & dialects are spoken in Toronto; the city publishes information for residents in 30 languages.
