When District 6270 Governor Jeff Reed meets with our club this year, he will be discussing 2017-18 Goals – ways in which we will **MAKE A DIFFERENCE** – and why they are important. The following is a list of our District Goals:

1. 50% of clubs in D6270 satisfy criteria to receive a **Presidential Citation**.
2. A **tree** planted for each Rotarian in D6270 (approximately 2,800 trees)
3. Net increase in D6270 **Membership** greater than +54 Rotarians.
4. Each club in D6270 contributes to **Polio Plus** with a total D6270 contribution > \$40,000.
5. TRF **Annual Fund** contributions from D6270 total > \$250K.
6. More than 500 Rotarians attend **TriCon 2018** Wisconsin District Conference.
7. Net increase in number of students participating in D6270 **Youth Exchange**.



A closer look at the **Presidential Citation**: this recognition is for clubs that are strong and making a positive difference in our communities by achieving goals related to Rotary’s three strategic priorities: to support and strengthen clubs, focus and increase humanitarian service, and enhance Rotary’s public image and awareness. Clubs will have the entire Rotary year — 1 July 2017 to 30 June 2018 — to achieve the citation’s goals

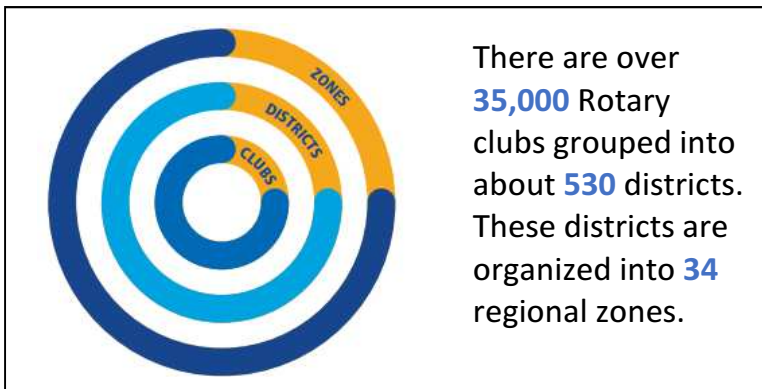
