## Thursday, December 27, 2007

Ted described the way the "magic of Rotary is that it allows ordinary people to do extraordinary things." Trips to Niger, the poorest country in the world became the highlight of our district governor's challenge. Both water and vaccinations for Polio, led to a greater understanding of Rotary commitments for Ted. He encouraged us all to further explore our dedication to the core missions of Rotary including, the elimination of polio in the world, access to clean water and education to improve literacy.

The **Lilac Bus**, a major club project for over 3 years, provides trips to low-to-moderate income seniors in the West Allis community lacking their own means of transportation for socialization. The initial success of this project has been a source of great pride for our club. It directly meets a community need and its ongoing operation is a goal shared by all. As this year comes to a close, please remember that matching funds, both from Joe Kempen and the Rotary Club of West Allis Foundation, go toward helping offset the costs of the **Lilac Bus**.
