Pocket Forest Project- Miyawaki Method

- Requires quite a small space, at least 20 square feet.
- Plant growth is 10 times faster, and vegetation 30 times denser than usual.
- One must maintain such a forest for at least 3 years, according to the **Miyawaki method**.
