- Saturday, October 7, 2023
- 11am - 5pm
- Carnegie Park, 2144 Third St., Livermore
- Public will have free admission to the park and will be able to purchase tickets to taste chili.
- Chili will be judged by event attendees. Awards will be presented at the end of the event to the first, second and third place winners.
- Additional booths including merchant, arts, crafts, nonprofits, and beer and wine will be at the event. Bands will play live music throughout the day.

Chili Cook Booth Information:

- Booths will be allocated a space in the park to accommodate a 10'x10' canopy/tent.
- Booth setup 9:00am - 10:30am
- Open to the public 11:00am - 5:00pm
 - Booths must be staffed and open from 11am - 5pm
- Your chili cooker's name/restaurant/organization logo and url (if provided) will be featured on RCLV website/social media and will be included in the event directory.
- There is no charge to participate in the event as a chili cooker.

The Rotary Club of Livermore Valley will provide:

- Mug and spoon for tasters (they will bring to you to be served).
- Paper liners for mugs so that you chili has a clean tasting surface.
- Hand sanitizer at your booth.
- Signage indicating your Cook Number, for judging purposes.
- Hand washing buckets, per Alameda County Health Code.

Please provide the following:

- Canopy/shade structure
- Table(s) and chair(s)
- 6 gallons of chili, prepared in a commercial kitchen.
- Heating element to keep your chili hot. You will need to provide your own power - generator or chafing dishes.

Deadline for Submission: September 1, 2023.
