Thank you for your interest in providing your unique chili in the 2022 Rotary Club of Livermore Valley Annual Chili Cook Off fundraiser at Carnegie Park on October 1, 2022.

- Saturday, October 1, 2022
- 11a - 5p at Carnegie Park, 2155 Third Street, Livermore
- Public will have free admission to the park and will be able to purchase tickets to taste chili.
- Chili will be judged by the event attendees as well as by local celebrity judges. Awards will be presented at the end of the event to the first, second, and third place winners.
- Additional booths including merchant, arts, crafts, nonprofits, beer, wine, and food vendors will be at the event. Bands will play live music throughout the day.

Chili Cooker Booth Information:

- Booths will be allocated a space in the park to accommodate a 10' x 10' canopy/tent.
- Setup of Booth from 9:00 am - 10:30 am
- Open to the Public 11:00 am - 5:00 pm
Booths must be staffed and open from 11- 5
- The chili cooker's name/restaurant/organization (and logo and website url if provided) will be featured on RCLV website and social media and will be included in the event directory.
- There is no charge to participate in the event as a chili cooker.

The Rotary Club of Livermore Valley will provide:

- Mug and spoon for tasters (They will bring to you to be served)
- Paper liners for mugs so that your chili has a clean tasting surface
- Hand sanitizer at your booth
- Signage indicating your Cook Number, for judging purposes
- Hand washing buckets, per Alameda County Health Code

Please provide the following:

- Canopy/tent
- Table(s) and chair(s)
- 5 gallons of chili, prepared in a commercial kitchen
- Heating element to keep your chili hot
You will need to provide your own power - generator or chafing dishes
- Signage indicating your name/organization
