- Open to the Public 11:00 am 5:00 pm Booths must be staffed and open from 11-5
- The chili cooker's name/restaurant/organization (and logo and website url if provided) will be featured on RCLV website and social media and will be included in the event directory.
- There is no charge to participate in the event as a chili cooker.

- Mug and spoon for tasters (They will bring to you to be served)
- · Paper liners for mugs so that your chili has a clean tasting surface
- · Hand sanitizer at your booth
- Signage indicating your Cook Number, for judging purposes
