Margarethe learned about wines during the 10-years she worked at Mirassou winery & champagne cellars.	
During this session, you'll understand the information on a wine label, including the varietal, vintage, and region of origin. Margarethe will also discuss the differences in taste between wines grown in different regions of California, as well as wines that go well with spicy food. You'll have the opportunity to taste a variety of wines and learn about the characteristics that make each one unique. Margarethe will explain how the winemaking process can affect the taste of a wine, including the impact of malolactic fermentation on Chardonnays.	
You will taste 3 cabernet sauvignons, all the same year, but grown in different regions. We will end with a wine that pairs well with Thai and other spicy foods. Overall, this promises to be a fun and informative session that will leave you with a greater appreciation and understanding of wine.
