
On March 31, 1975, "Valley Campus" opened as the Livermore Education Center of Chabot College.

On January 7, 1991, LPC received full accreditation as an independent college from the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges.

#### Overview – Educational Master Plan




- Tri-Valley residents are highly educated
  - 55% of adults have a bachelor's degree or higher
- The overall college-going rate of high school completers is 80%
  - Asians have the highest college-going rate at 88%
  - Latinx have the lowest college-going rate at 70%
- Approximately 30% of local high school graduates attend LPC
  - California State University, East Bay is the top transfer institution

#### Overview – Educational Master Plan



- 71% of students are 24 years old or younger
  - 20% of students are 30 years old or older
- 54% of students are first-generation college students
  - 76% of Latinx students are first-generation college students
- 31% of Las Positas students are considered low-income

#### **Eligible Students:**


First-time college students that have not attended college before




