 - ✗ ● Camp Enterprise ● Junior Achievement
 - ✗ ● Coaching ● Sports Team Management
 - ✗ ● 4H Club ● Militia
 - ✗ ● Student Council ● Political Involvement
 - ✗ ● Community Service ● Other Leadership Program

Look for enthusiasm, energy, smarts, inclination to teamwork, self starting. etc.



“HOW TO SELECT DELIGATES”

- + Contact your high school principal or guidance counselor.
- + Get them to nominate – best and brightest based on criteria
- + E-Mail the selected students the application & release forms
- + Establish a 2 or 3 person Interview Panel
- + Panel meets students individually at the school for interview - ½ hour per – prepare questions from criteria...
- + Select finalist(s)
- + Obtain the Signatures of Deligate(s) & Parents on Form 1
- + Make sure those not selected don't get a feeling of failure by working with the person who sponsored their nomination

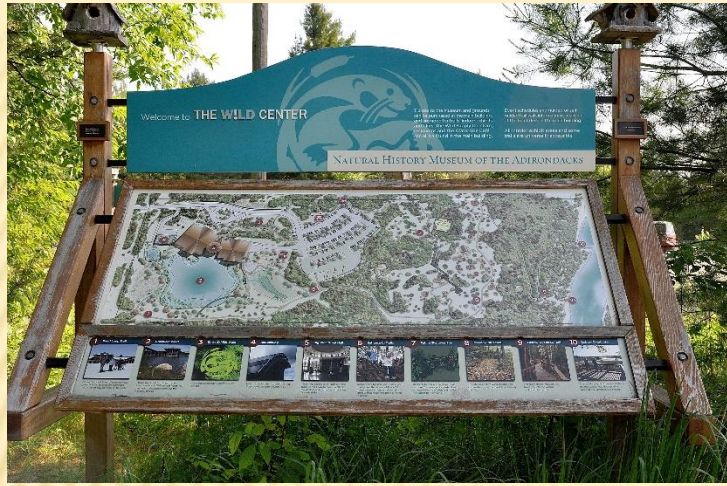
