Award Descriptions

Please note: You may nominate a youth for more than one category

Academic Achievement

This award recognizes students who demonstrate exceptional academic achievement.

Community Involvement

Special recognition is given to a student who demonstrates participation, dedication and compassion and/or leadership skills and creativity through implementing actions to better our community.

Community Leadership

This award is for students who demonstrate significant leadership efforts in their community.

Compassion award

This award recognizes students who give selflessly of themselves in order to improve the lives of others.

Courage award

The courage award recognizes students who demonstrate personal courage by taking positive action against social biases or in the face adversity and/or personal tragedy.

Dance/ Drama Award

For an individual who excels at embodying physical expression and emotion through timing and movement and is dedicated to their craft.

Entrepreneurship

This award is for a student who demonstrates forward thinking in business innovation and in developing commercial relations.

International Ambassador Award

A Canadian who is dedicated to peacemaking by making it their personal mission to link and improve relations home and abroad.

Music (instrumental)

This award provides recognition to students who demonstrate exceptional musical abilities and talent.

Music (vocal)

This award gives special recognition to students who demonstrate vocal skill and talent.

Resilience & Adaptation

This award is to recognize students who demonstrate resilience and strong adaptation skills when facing challenging situations/ conditions.

Sports award

This award is to give special recognition to students who have realized outstanding sporting achievements.

Technological Innovations

The successful candidate is one who excels in computer sciences with online innovation and communications

Visual arts award

For a student who demonstrates excellence and innovation in visual arts.

Other

This category is to provide recognition to an outstanding student whose accomplishments may not fit into the above categories.
