PROGRAM

Tonight’s program was arranged by Gary Pearce, who introduced Mike Rapella, former president of the Minerva Club and candidate for Carroll County Municipal Court judge. He gave us a talk about bankruptcy when given a choice of three topics: Bankruptcy, Family Law, and the work of the Prosecutor. Mike has been a lawyer for several years, working first as a defense lawyer with Marty Chapman when he moved back to Minerva with his family. In his explanation of bankruptcy he outlined several recent changes to bankruptcy law to reduce the number of frivolous or ill-advised cases. Bankruptcy’s greatest asset is to allow individuals and businesses to regain their credit status and become contributors to their community once again instead of being stranded in a situation of drowning debt. After a question and answer session, the club expressed their appreciation by presenting him with a Rotary 4-Way Test pen.

There being no further business, the Club adjourned at 7:15PM.
