- PDG Jack installed the new Avenue of Service Chairs this evening. Kathy Smith is our Secretary/Treasurer, but she will not be installed until she returns from Canada. Susan Anderson is our Sargent-at-Arms.
- Pres. Randy read a letter from the Lake Mohawk Trail and Garden Club about their dedication of a Blue Star Memorial Marker on Wednesday, Aug. 17, at 4:30. Attendees are asked to pre-register for the event. Randy has the information you need.
