**ROTARY CLUB OF MASSILLON
BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES
FEBRUARY 4, 2020**

The Board of Directors met at Kozmo's Grille on Tuesday, February 4, 2020. The following members were present: Keith Nutter, Tom Jingo, Chad Hartman, John Shultz, Linda Litman, Laura Tubo, Barb Schumacher, and Matt Hull.

The minutes of the January 7, 2020 meeting were presented for approval. Upon a motion by Mrs. Litman and a second by Mr. Hull, the minutes were approved, with two minor corrections.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Mr. Jingo presented a notice of resignation from Robert Gessner. Mr. Gessner has been a member of the club for many years, but has recently retired and feels that it is time to leave the club. Upon a motion by Mr. Jingo and a second by Ms. Schumacher, the Board accepted Mr. Gessner's resignation, with regret.

Lori Kotagide-Boron also submitted a notice of resignation. Upon a motion by Mr. Hull and a second by Mrs. Litman, her resignation was accepted, with regret.

The Board next considered a Corporate Membership application from Brahler's Cleaning & Restoration, Inc. Marie Brahler would be the primary member and Todd Brahler and Joy Plumley would be the two alternate members. Matt Hull is the sponsor. Upon a motion by Mr. Hartman and a second by Mrs. Tubo, the Board approved the Brahler application for presentation to the club membership.

A membership application for Todd Loxley was presented for approval. Mr. Loxley is a financial advisor for Edward Jones. His sponsor is John Shultz. Upon a motion by Mr. Hartman and a second by Mrs. Litman, Mr. Loxley's application was approved for presentation to the club membership.

CLUB SERVICE:

Mr. Hartman presented a request from the Massillon Museum for financial support for their annual Big Read Project. The Club Service Committee recommended that we provide a \$1,000 grant for this project. Upon a motion by Mrs. Schumacher and a second by Mr. Hartman, the Board approved \$1,000 for the Massillon Museum request.

Next, Mr. Hartman asked the Board to consider approving \$200 for the Massillon Fire Department's program of providing smoke detectors for local families. Upon a motion by

Ms. Schumacher and a second by Mrs. Litman, the Board authorized \$200 for that program.

We are still seeking volunteers from the club for the June 6th IMPACT Massillon Project.

MEMBERSHIP:

Even though the Massillon Museum's Corporate Membership application has been approved by the Board, it needs to be presented to the club membership, with the note that the membership will not become effective until March 1, 2020.

Vince Pedro and the two alternate members from the Boys and Girls Club will be formally introduced to the club as Corporate members at the February 6th club meeting.

PROGRAMS:

Club meeting programs are scheduled through most of May. The club's annual Installation Dinner is scheduled for June 18th. There will not be any noon club meeting that day. The Board discussed plans for our annual major fund-raiser.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mrs. Litman advised the Board that the City of Massillon is moving forward with plans for the park pavilion. They are currently looking for a new location and waiting for a bid from the contractor. They have set a budget of over \$100,000 for this project. It was the consensus of the Board that we need to determine how much funding we will be able to make available to support this project.

NEW BUSINESS:

A question was raised regarding our club's relationship with the Massillon Rotary Foundation. It was noted that the Foundation is a separate legal entity, even though Rotarians from our club occupy positions on the Foundation's Board of Directors.

NEXT MEETING:

The next regularly scheduled meeting on the Board of Directors is Tuesday, March 3rd, at 11:30am, at Kozmo's Grille.

ADJOURNMENT:

Upon a motion by Mr. Hull, the meeting was adjourned at 1:00pm.
