ROTARY CLUB OF MASSILLON
BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 5, 2019

The Board of Directors met at Social at the Stone House on Tuesday, November 5, 2019. The following members were present: Tom Jingo, Barb Schumacher, John Shultz, Linda Litman, Keith Nutter, Kim Edwards, Chad Hartman, Matt Hull, Joe Logan, Richard Regula, Laura Tubo, Dick Leffler, Michelle Hartman, Jim Stanford, and Dr. Bill Leffler.

The minutes for the October Board meeting were not yet ready for action by the Board.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Mr. Leffler circulated the Accounts Aging Report dated October 31, 2019. Although there are several accounts that are over ninety days, most of those are for small amounts, and Mr. Leffler was not overly concerned about being able to collect on those accounts.

Mr. Leffler presented the club's financial report for the period, July 1, 2019 – September 30, 2019. Total income for that period was \$7,724.79 and total expenses were \$13,522.23, leaving a negative balanced of \$5,797.44. Mr. Leffler advised the Board that several large expenses occur during this period, such as the International Convention expenses, International semiannual dues and District annual dues, the Distinguished Citizen event, and Operation WARM expenses. He is confident that income will catch up with expenses, as the club -year progresses.

The Board was advised that we have approved funding in the amount of \$1,400 for the RYLA Conference. Upon a motion by Mr. Hartman and a second by Ms. Schumacher, the Board approved sending four students to the RYLA Conference.

Upon a motion by Mr. Jingo and a second by Mr. Logan, the Board approved the Treasurer's Report.

CLUB SERVICE:

Mr. Hartman reported that the most current project is Operation Warm. He also noted that the response by volunteers for the Meals on Wheels project has been somewhat poor.

MEMBERSHIP:

Mr. Shultz reported that he had provided a new member orientation program for a prospective member from COMDOT. That individual was checking to see if his company will pay for his club expenses.

Rotarian Vince Pedro has requested that his membership be converted to Corporate Membership for the Boys & Girls Club of Massillon. Mr. Pedro would be the Designated Primary Member. Upon a motion by Mr. Shultz and a second by Mrs. Hartman, the Board approved that request.

A discussion regarding the club's problem with low meeting attendance followed.

PROGRAMS:

Most of the programs are booked through February. We will invite a high school choral group to provide one of the programs in December or January. The Board decided to cancel the January 2nd club meeting, due to that date's proximity to the New Years Day holiday. We will encourage members to invite non-Rotarian guests to the club's socials.

OLD BUSINESS:

President Nutter will follow-up with Jay Bomze on the survey of Rotary signs that need to be replaced or repaired.

Mrs. Litman advised the Board that in regards to the Pavilion project, all parties are in agreement with them basic plan, but many details still remain to be worked out.

NEW BUSINESS:

We will support the Salvation Army by providing volunteers to man a kettle on Wednesday, December 18th.

The Board discussed the need to acquire a 4-Way Test banner.

November is Rotary Foundation Awareness Month, and we will have one program devoted to the Foundation.

It was suggested that, in order to promote more volunteer participation in the club's projects, we should make a greater effort to emphasize the goals and objectives of those projects to our members.

President-Elect Matt Hull is interested in attending the 2020 Rotary International Convention.

Mr. Hull will form a planning committee for our major fund-raiser.

The Nominating Committee for our election of officers and directors will be composed of: Keith Nutter, Matt Hull, Linda Litman, and Chad Hartman.

The Board discussed how we might use the Social at the Stone House for future meetings and club events.

NEXT MEETING:

The next regularly schedule meeting of the Board of Directors is Tuesday, December 3rd, at 11:30am, at Kozmo's Grille.

ADJOURNMENT:

Upon a motion by Mr. Hull, the meeting was adjourned at 1:10pm.
