**ROTARY CLUB OF MASSILLON
BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES
DECEMBER 4, 2018**

The Board of Directors met at Kozmo's Grille on Tuesday, December 4, 2018. The following members were present: Michelle Hartman, Dr. Bill Leffler, Jim Stanford, Matt Hull, Chad Hartman, Tom Jingo, John Shultz, Joe Logan, and Sherie Brown.

President Michelle Hartman called the meeting to order. The minutes of the November 6, 2018 meeting were presented for approval. Upon a motion by Mr. Logan and a second by Mrs. Brown, the minutes were approved, with one minor correction.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Mr. Jingo presented a notice of resignation from Mitch Kendall. Mr. Kendall had hoped to relocate his office in Massillon, but found a more suitable site in Jackson Township. Upon a motion by Mr. Hull and a second by Mr. Logan, the Board voted to accept the resignation of Mr. Kendall.

Mr. Jingo reported that Sean Craney has requested that his Rotary membership be transferred from the Canal Fulton club to Massillon. He was a member in good standing with the Canal Fulton club and he has gone through our new member orientation program with John Shultz. Upon a motion by Dr. Leffler and a second by Mr. Shultz, the Board approved the transfer of Mr. Craney's membership.

The percentage of attendance by active members for the three club meetings in November was 43%.

Mr. Jingo advised the Board that he is scheduled for hip replacement surgery on December 10th and, therefore, would not be able to attend meetings for at least a short period of time. He will, however, be able to conduct most of his secretarial duties from home after his surgery.

CLUB SERVICE:

We have signed the commitment papers for IMPACT Massillon 2019. We made a \$200 contribution to Veterans Appreciation Dinner in October. With contributions from club members, 12 turkeys were provided for the River Tree/Massillon Thanksgiving dinner, which was attended by 450. The Health Fair at Mercy West will be conducted this weekend, sponsored by the Massillon Rotary Foundation and staffed with several volunteers from our club. The bell ringing for the Salvation Army at Fishers Foods was conducted on December 1st.

MEMBERSHIP:

Mr. Shultz reported that he has scheduled a new member orientation with Paul Salvino, of the Massillon Public Schools. It was, also, suggested, that Cari Derheimer be approached as a possible new member.

INTERNATIONAL:

The Board discussed the possibility of taking on an international project. It was suggested that we should considered the Guatemala Literacy Project, which works to provide better educational opportunities in that country. This project can be done in partnership with the District and Rotary International, which will expand the scope of the project.

PROGRAMS:

Programs have been arranged through March 23rd. The December 27th club meeting has been cancelled, due to its proximity to the Christmas holiday.

ACTION ITEMS:

We have received no more information from the City regarding the renovation of them downtown Triangle Park project. We can't make a commitment of any kind without having full knowledge of the planned renovation.

The Board discussed the suggestion that we host other service club members at some meetings in order to learn more about their activities and goals, share information about our activities and goals, determine if there might be ways that we can collaborate on some community projects and, perhaps, recruit some new members.

The next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board is Tuesday, January 8th, at 11:30am, at Kozmo's Grille.

ADJOURNMENT:

Upon a motion by Mr. Hartman and a second by Mr. Logan, the meeting was adjourned at 1:00pm.
