NOVEMBER 2, 2021**

The Board of Directors met at Kozmo's Grille on Tuesday, November 2, 2021. The following members were present: Barb Schumacher, Tom Jingo, Jeff Brest, Joe Logan, Kathy Shultz, Dr. Bill Leffler, Dan Swartz, Dick Leffler, Richard Regula, Matt Hull, Michelle Hartman, Todd Loxley, and Chad Hartman.

The minutes of the September 7, 2021 Board meeting were presented for approval. Two minor errors were noted. Upon a motion by Mrs. Shultz and a second by Ms. Schumacher, the amended minutes were approved.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Mr. Jingo reported the Carolyn Worthen had recently undergone knee surgery and would not be able to attend meetings until sometime in December. She has been placed on a Leave-of-Absence through December 16, 2021.

The average weekly meeting attendance percentage of active members in October was 42%.

Mr. Jingo advised the Board that we currently have no list of Sergeant-at-Arms duties. He was asked to draft a list of those duties for the Board to consider at the December Board meeting.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Mr. Leffler circulated the most recent Aging Account Report and reported that he had been in contact with most of those who have a large outstanding amount. In response to some questions, he explained the club's billing process.

CLUB SERVICE:

Our Meals-On-Wheels schedule is fully covered through the end of December. The date for our Salvation Army Bells project has not yet been established.

MEMBERSHIP:

Mrs. Shultz reported that she has been contacted by a party interested in our Corporate Membership program, and that she is following-up with that prospect.

MASSILLON ROTARY FOUNDATION:

Mr. Logan reported that the Foundation's Board of Directors next meeting will be in December.

PROGRAMS:

Mr. Swartz reported that we have programs scheduled to cover all meeting dates in November and December. He has scheduled a club tour of the Stark County Sheriff's

Department Weapons Training Center in Massillon on January 13th. The Board discussed a possible club Christmas party or social in December.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

The Board discussed possible fund-raising events. Mr. Swartz reported that Jay Bomze has volunteered to organize a Pick 3 lottery fund-raiser. We might consider doing a joint pancake breakfast with the Canton Rotary the week of next year's Massillon-McKinley game. We still need to have a major fund-raising event.

President Hartman is making arrangements for a representative of the Canton Rotary to attend an upcoming meeting and present us with a check for \$500 to settle our annual wager on the outcome of the Massillon-McKinley game. We will be donating that \$500 to the SAM Center.

We are participating in an international project with several other area Rotary clubs to provide face masks (for COVID) for Kenya. Upon a motion by Mr. Hull and a second by Mrs. Shultz, the Board approved a contribution of \$165 for that project.

President Hartman asked the Board to consider the appointment of Angela Cooper to fill a vacancy on the Board. Upon motion by Mr. Jingo and a second by Mr. Hull, the Board approved Angela Cooper's appointment to the Board.

NEXT MEETING:

The next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Directors is Tuesday, December 7th, at 11:30am, at Kozmo's Grille.

ADJOURNMENT:

Upon a motion by Mr. Jingo and a second by Mr. Hull, the meeting was adjourned at 12:55pm.

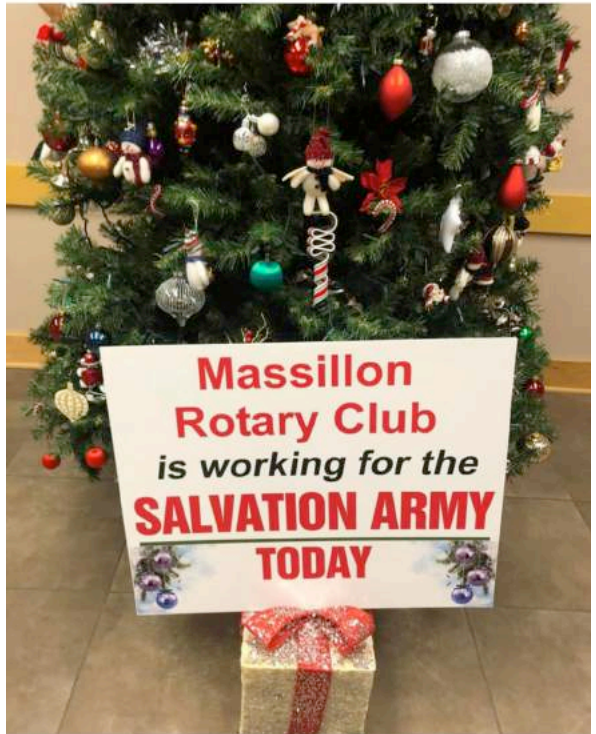
