BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES MAY 3, 2022

The Board of Directors met at Kozmo's Grille on Tuesday, May 3, 2022. The minutes of the April 5, 2022 Board meeting were presented for approval. Upon a motion by Ms. Schumacher and a second by Mr. Regula, the minutes were approved, as amended.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Mr. Jingo presented a request from Jenn Warner to change her membership status from Individual to Corporate for the Legacy Group. Upon a motion by Mrs. Hartman and a second by Mr. Hull, the Board approved Jenn Warner's request. Mr. Jingo was directed to follow-up with Jenn Warner regarding the details for making this change.

The April average percentage weekly attendance by active members was 50%.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Mr. Leffler circulated the Accounts Aging Report for the past few months and commented on the status of two former members and three current members who are significantly behind in their financial, obligations to the club.

Mr. Leffler asked the Board to consider retiring the debts of Dr. Tony Perry and Scott Schnabel, both of which he considered to be unrecoverable.

Upon a motion by Nutter and a second by Mr. Loxley, the Board voted to retire the debt of Dr. Tony Perry, with one vote in opposition.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Hartman and a second by Ms. Schumacher, the Board voted to retire the debt of Scott Schnabel, with one vote in opposition.

CLUB SERVICE:

Mrs. Hartman reported that the Drive-Thru Baby Shower, for needy mother's-to-be, is scheduled for May 23rd.

We need a volunteer for Meals-on-Wheels for May 20th.

Mr. Hartman reported that there be a need for additional funds for our portion of the IMPACT Massillon Project, since we may be asked to take on a second house.

Mrs. Hartman will contact Parks & Recreation Director, Steve Pedro, regarding a clean-up project for the Seesan Memorial Garden.

MEMBERSHIP:

The new member induction for Richard Kobasic is scheduled for May 12th.

Mrs. Shultz has scheduled the required new member orientation for Mr. Fred Horner of Advanced Industrial Roofing.

A discussion followed on how best to promote this project in the community.

President Hartman reported that Engravers Gallery & Signs can make the Rotary signs that we wish to display at various entrances to Massillon. He suggested blue signs with white lettering and that the signs should be reflective. The final design will need to be approved by the Board of Directors.


