BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES
APRIL 6, 2021**

The Board of Directors met at Kozmo's Grille on Tuesday, April 6, 2021. The following members were present: Chad Hartman, Daniel Swartz, Tom Jingo, Dr. Bill Leffler, Keith Nutter, Matt Hull, and Todd Loxley.

The minutes of the March 2, 2021 Board meeting were presented for approval. Upon a motion by Mr. Hartman and a second by Mr. Nutter, the minutes were approved, as presented.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Mr. Jingo reported that the average weekly attendance at club meetings by active members in March was 45.29%. A discussion followed regarding the reasons why attendance was not higher and when and how we might expect an improvement.

CLUB SERVICE:

President Hull shared a list of possible club projects provided by Michelle Hartman. That list included:

- SAM Center: To work together to help with the Food Pantry and to assist with procuring a fruit cart on wheels.
- Manners Matter in Massillon is doing a park clean-up at Reservoir Park on May 1st at 10am.
- Provide volunteers for the Stark County Baby Shower at the Goodwill campus in Canton on May 8th.
- Declare June as Purple Bag Month for Massillon Rotary.
- Provide and man a water station for the June 6th RBW Veterans benefit group Ultra Run fund-raiser.
- A Seesan Park project.

The Board also discussed the current status of Lincoln Park Project. We now understand that the City Recreation Department has found a much less expensive way to provide permanent restroom facilities for the park. Mr. Swartz suggested that we work with the Recreation Department to provide a map of the Disc Golf course, with an inscription that notes that the course has been provided by the City Recreation Department and the Rotary Club of Massillon.

INTERNATIONAL:

Dr. Leffler reported that he is looking for a project with which we could partner with other area Rotary clubs and receive funding support from Rotary International.

PROGRAMS UPDATE:

Mr. Hartman discussed the programs scheduled for the meetings on April 8th and April 22nd.

OLD BUSINESS:

President Hull asked the Board members to assist in encouraging club members to submit their bios and pictures for the newsletter.

NEW BUSINESS:

President Hull reported on the April 5th podcast that he and the Canton Rotary president participated in at the BW3 in Massillon. As part of the podcast, the two presidents discussed the work of Rotary in their communities. It also provided an opportunity to settle the annual wager on the Massillon-Canton McKinley football game from last fall.

NEXT MEETING:

The next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Directors is Tuesday, May 4th, at 11:30am, at Kozmo's Grille.

ADJOURNMENT:

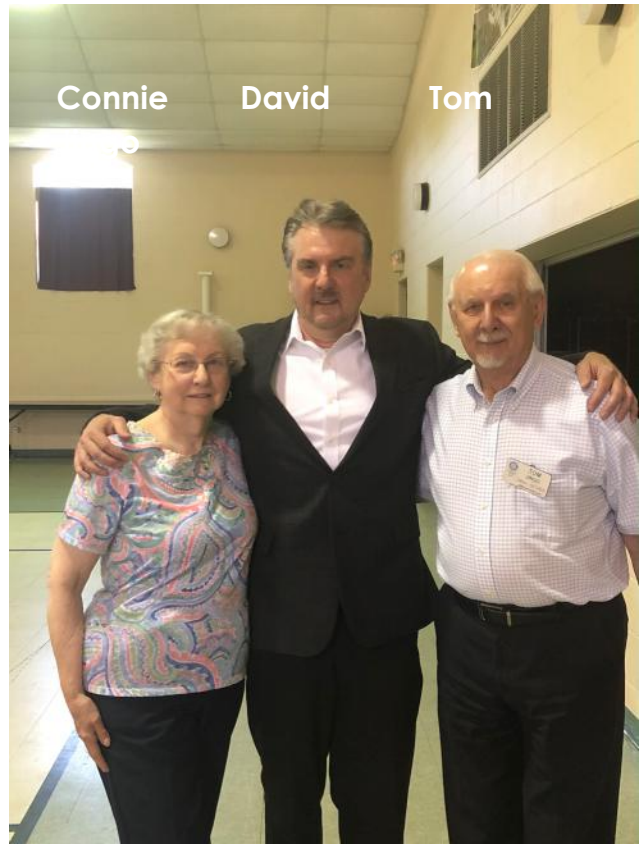
Upon a motion by Mr. Hartman and a second by Mr. Jingo, the meeting was adjourned at 12:59pm.

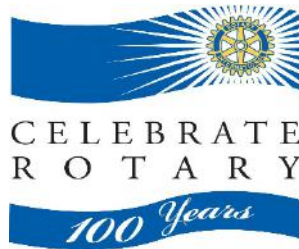
