My name is Laurie Dutton and I am a Speech-Language Pathologist in the Massillon City School District. I work with a student who is diagnosed with a severe expressive communication disorder which limits his ability to communicate his thoughts and ideas, share his feelings, tell what he needs or wants, participate in social interactions with peers, ask and respond to questions and so much more. He understands what others are saying to him, but he has a difficult time expressing (using his sounds and words to communicate). One can imagine how frustrating this would be, to know what you want to say and have the desire to communicate, but not feel "heard" or "understood" by others. This lack of communication has led to many frustrating days for this student at home and school. Last year, this student was evaluated and was found to be a good candidate for a communication device. This device would help him with the communication needs that he has. Unfortunately, there have been many obstacles in getting the device in his hands as there is a process for funding and that process takes time. Finally, after meeting all the requirements for insurance approval, there was a balance remaining on his account that needed to be paid before the device could be shipped. The student's family was unable to afford the remaining balance, which was quite a significant amount. I reached out to several area organizations to see if any could help with this expense. I was extremely impressed with the very quick response from the Rotary Club of Massillon! Not only were they willing to help, but they were willing to pay the remaining balance off so that this student's device could be shipped to him as soon as possible! The Rotary Club of Massillon "filled the gap" and is helping us give this student his "voice"!!! What an exciting moment it will be when he receives his device!

On behalf of myself, the Massillon City School District, and the families we serve, we would like to express our deepest gratitude to the Board of Directors of the Rotary Club of Massillon for their generous donation and contribution to the funding of a communication device for one of our students. This device will have a profound impact on our student's life, giving him the ability to express himself and communicate effectively with others, which will greatly improve his confidence, decrease frustrations and improve his overall quality of life. We were overwhelmed with the donation and quick response to our request! What an amazing organization and support you are to our community! 


