JANUARY 7, 2020**

The Board of Directors met at Kozmo's Grille on Tuesday, January 7, 2020. The following members were present: Jim Stanford, Tom Jingo, Joe Logan, Kim Edwards, Barb Schumacher, Linda Litman, Chad Hartman, Keith Nutter, John Shultz, Matt Hull, Richard Regula, Dr. Bill Leffler, and Michelle Hartman.

The minutes of the December 3, 2019 meeting were presented for approval. Upon a motion by Mr. Regula and a second by Mr. Stanford, the minutes were approved, as presented.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Mr. Jingo presented a Leave of Absence request from Judge Edward Elum for a period of two years, effective January 1, 2020. Upon a motion by Mr. Hull and a second by Mrs. Hartman the Board approved Judge Elum's request. Mr. Jingo was instructed to see if Judge Elum might be eligible for Exempt status and, if so, to check with him to see if he would prefer to go that route.

The percentage of active members attending the two club meetings in December was 61%.

CLUB SERVICE:

Mr. Hartman reported that the club's Meals on Wheels route had recently been shortened, requiring fewer volunteers. The club is registered to participate in the June 6th IMPACT Massillon Project. Keith Nutter will provide the leadership for that project.

MEMBERSHIP:

Mr. Shultz reported that Todd Loxley was scheduled to go through the new member orientation. The Massillon Museum Board has approved participation in our Corporate Membership program. Vince Pedro and the two alternate Corporate members from the Massillon Boys and Girls Club will be formally introduced to the club at an upcoming meeting. The Tuslaw Board of Education is still considering joining as a Corporate Member.

Upon a motion by Mr. Shultz and a second by Mrs. Litman, the Board approved the Corporate Membership application of the Massillon Museum.

INTERNATIONAL:

Dr. Leffler advised the Board that he is looking for an International project for the club and has narrowed his choices to either the Shelter Box Project or water filters.

PROGRAMS:

The programs for our weekly club meetings have been scheduled through early May. There will be a Rotary Social on January 30th and a Rotary Auction on February 20th.

OLD BUSINESS:

There will be a Paul Brown Scholarship Committee meeting in January.

The club's Fund- Raising Committee will meet on January 9th.

NEW BUSINESS:

The 4-Way Test Banner has been ordered. The District 6650 Spring Conference is scheduled for May 16th.

NEXT MEETING:

The next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Directors is Tuesday, February 4th, at 11:30am, at Kozmo's Grille.

Upon a motion by Mr. Stanford the meeting was adjourned at 12:35pm.
