BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES
JANUARY 2, 2024**

The Board of Directors met at Kozmo's Grille on Tuesday, January 2, 2024. The following members were present: Dan Swartz, Chad Hartman, Kathy Shultz, Keith Nutter, Matt Hull, Jeff Brest, Angela Cooper, Richard Regula and Dr. Bill Leffler.

The minutes of the November 7, 2023 Board meeting were presented for approval. Upon a motion by Mr. Regula and a second by Mr. Nutter, the minutes were approved, as presented.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

No report.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Upon direction from the Board, Mrs. Shultz reported that \$50,000 of Club funds would be moved into an interest-bearing CD at Farmer's National Bank.

CLUB SERVICE:

Mr. Hartman reported that the list of dates for delivering for Meals on Wheels would be sent out to all Club members. There has been no indication as of yet as to a date for Impact Massillon and whether it will be happening this year.

The Board discussed reaching out to Habitat for Humanity as a potential Rotary service project in 2024 similar to prior years. The Board also discussed certain monetary requirements for participating in such Habitat builds.

Mr. Hartman reported that the Ukranian family he is helping to bring to Massillon will likely arrive in January.

MEMBERSHIP:

Mrs. Shultz reported that she has contacted Taylor Clark with Shanklin Heating and Cooling to discuss potential membership opportunities with her. Mrs. Shultz also reported that she would follow up with Mayor Slutz re: potential membership.

MASSILLON ROTARY FOUNDATION:

Mr. Swartz reported that grant recipients will be coming to the January 4, 2024 regular Rotary meeting to accept grant awards and make a presentation to the Club as to their intended use of the grant funds. The next quarterly Foundation Board meeting is scheduled for January 11th.

Mr. Swartz also reported that the Foundation provided additional funds for coats to provide to Operation Warm that were unused this past year, and that such funds would be put towards the purchase of coats for next year.

PROGRAMS:

Mr. Stanford informed the Board of the upcoming program dates and speakers.

NEW BUSINESS:

No report.

PRESIDENT’S REPORT:

Mr. Swartz presented a request from the Massillon Museum for a \$2,000 contribution to help fund their Big Read event. Mr. Swartz indicated that such request would be handled by the Rotary Foundation.

Mr. Swartz advised that Alex Coon would be assisting with the 4-way speech contest, but that the RYLA chair position was open. Mr. Swartz indicated he would ask the Club membership if anyone would be interested in fulfilling such position.

Mr. Swartz also indicated to the Board he would send out a list of current Board Members with an indication as to when each individual’s Board term expires. The Board then engaged in a general discussion regarding Club officers for 2024.
