**ROTARY CLUB OF MASSILLON
BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES
AUGUST 13, 2019**

The Board of Directors met at Kozmo's Grille on Tuesday, August 13, 2019. The following members were present: Dick Leffler, Tom Jingo, Richard Regula, Keith Nutter, Dr. Bill Leffler, Barb Schumacher, Chad Hartman, Jim Stanford, and Laura Tubo.

President Nutter called the meeting to order. The minutes of the July 2, 2019 meeting were presented for approval. Upon a motion by Dr. Leffler and a second by Mr. Regula, the minutes were approved, as presented.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Mr. Jingo presented a letter of resignation from Les Peine. Rev. Peine no longer resides in the Massillon area and his work schedule does not permit him to be in Massillon on club meeting dates. Upon a motion by Ms. Schumacher and a second by Mr. Stanford, the Board accepted Rev. Peine's resignation, with regret.

Mr. Jingo informed the Board that Jason Harris had not responded to the letter from the Board in which he was given a deadline to begin making good on his overdue financial obligations to the club. Upon a motion by Mr. Jingo and a second by Mr. Hartman, the Board voted to terminate the membership of Jason Harris, effective immediately.

The average percentage of attendance by active members for the four club meetings in July was 53%.

Mr. Jingo noted that there had been some confusion over the fact that the Board meeting date for August had been moved back one week and several members had come a week early. Mr. Jingo expressed regret for not sending out a notice regarding the change of date and apologized to those members who had been inconvenienced.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Mr. Leffler circulated the Accounts Aging Report for July and indicated that there were a couple of the accounts that he had some concerns about. Ms. Schumacher volunteered to contact one of those members and Mr. Jingo was asked to check on the possibility that the other member's payments may have been mistakenly sent to Rotary International.

Mr. Leffler presented the proposed club operating budget for 2019-2020. Proposed total revenues for that period would be \$44,950 and the proposed total expenditures for the

same period would be \$44,950. Upon a motion by Dr. Leffler and a second by Mr. Stanford, the Board voted to approve a new member initiation fee of \$35, a new member badge fee of \$15, and annual member dues of \$220. Upon a motion by Ms. Tubo and a second by Ms. Schumacher, the voted to approve the proposed budget for 2019-2020.

CLUB SERVICE:

The Buddy Bench Project has been completed and we will hear a report on that project at our August 22nd club meeting. The club made a donation of 600 sharpies to the Massillon Middle schools. Plans are being made for Project Warm and the Salvation Army Bell Ringing project. The Committee is considering other projects to support the schools.

PROGRAMS:

Speakers and programs are schedule through September.

OLD BUSINESS:

We are still waiting for an update on the need to replace some of our signs around the community as well as the Welcome to Massillon sign.

NEW BUSINESS:

Upon a motion by Mr. Jingo and a second by Mr. Leffler, the Board acted to change the membership status of Doug Kleinschmidt to Honorary Member.

NEXT MEETING:

The next regularly scheduled Board meeting is Tuesday, September 3rd, at 11:30am, at Kozmo's Grille.

ADJOURNMENT:

Upon a proper motion the meeting was adjourned at 12:55pm.
