The Tuscora Park ConnectionTuscora Park is Rotary's best-known service project. RTY, Inc. is is a not-for-profit corporation responsible for the Tuscora Park Rides, Concessions, Amphitheater, and Park Place Youth Center. Club members work closely with the City's Park staff to operate and maintain these community assets.

...Club members provide "hands on" service to the Park, working in May to do cleanup, spread mulch and plant flowers.

Fundraising

...The Rotary Healthcheck is the Club's largest fundraising event.

...Sponsor donations support Storybook Lane each Christmas season.

...The "Salute Freedom" American Flag Project and other smaller projects generate funds donated to a variety of community projects.

Eligibility

People of all ages in all professional or management positions, living or working in New Philadelphia or the surrounding areas may be considered for membership. All membership applications are subject to Board approval.

Obligations of Members Members are expected to attend a minimum of 60% of club meetings per year. You can "make up" a missed meeting at any other Rotary Club. Members are expected to actively participate in projects and committees, become project leaders, and eventually consider service as a club officer.

Cost of Membership Rotary dues are \$140 per year. A \$10 meal charge is assessed even if the member does not attend the meeting. Annual charges for Rotary Club membership will total about \$600. Invoices are sent out quarterly.
