

## **The Jack Mansfield Memorial Scholarship Fund**

### **Who Can Apply?**

A senior who resides in Plain Township; or attends a Plain Township School or is the custodial child or grandchild of a Plain Township Rotarian.

### **Scholarship Information**

The Jack Mansfield Memorial Scholarship Fund was established by Eric and Susan Mansfield and family to honor, Jack Mansfield, who died in September 2020. Jack had a successful career as a financial planner and owned his own business for many years before retiring in 2008. He was very involved in both Young Life Stark County and The Rotary Club of Plain Township. He also devoted many hours to other organizations during his lifetime.

The purpose of this fund is to provide an annual scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 to a student in pursuit of his/her post-secondary education. The scholarship is intended to support a student who is highly motivated to succeed and for whom the award will have an impact both personally and financially.

### **Review**

In addition to Eric and Susan Mansfield, the applications will also be reviewed by the Jack Mansfield Scholarship Advisors - a committee comprised of Plain Township Rotary Members. One applicant will be chosen annually.

In conjunction with completing the application form, each applicant will be required to write a short (250 to 500 word) essay answering one these two questions:

- 1) Explain how a volunteer opportunity has had a positive impact on you.
- 2) How you have contributed to your community while attending high school.

### **Eligibility:**

Senior who:

1. Resides in Plain Township; or  
Attends a Plain Township School; or  
Is the custodial child or grandchild of a Plain Township Rotarian;
2. Senior planning to attend a post-secondary institution;
3. Student service to others is exemplary;
4. Students receives nomination from an adult who is not a family member.

### **Guidelines:**

1. Application is to be completed by the student, clearly indicating service to others through community, school, church, or other activities.
2. Service is to be documented for the period of time the student was a junior and senior.
3. Service hours are to be estimated and adults (other than parents) capable of verifying the service are to be identified.
4. The scholarship will be paid by August 15, 2021 upon submission of verification of entrance into an institution of higher education to the awarded applicant.
