Eligibility

- 1. Senior who:
 - A. Resides in Plain Township; or
 - B. Attends a Plain Township School; or
 - C. Is the custodial child of a Plain Township Rotarian.
- 2. Senior planning to attend a post-secondary institution.
- 3. Student who after the first semester of senior year had a GPA
- 4. Student service to other is exemplary.
- 5. Students receives nomination from a community or school adult who is not a family member.

Guidelines:

- 1. Application is to be completed by the student, clearly indicating service to other through community, school, church, and other activities.
- 2. Service is to be documented for the period of time the student was a junior and senior.
- 3. Service hours are to be estimated and adults (other than parents) capable of verifying the service are to be identified. (preferably 150 hours during each of the junior and senior years) senior years)
- 4. The scholarship will be paid by August 15th, 2022 upon submission of verification of entrance into an institution of higher education to the awarded applicant. Verification must be submitted by August 10, 2022 to receive funding. If not, another candidate will be chosen.
