We provide scholarships to **ENFIELD** residents who are entering their **JUNIOR** or **SENIOR** year of college or other post-high school education. There is no age limitation for applicants.

DO NOT USE YOUR NAME on any of the four requested essays. We use control numbers and provide your essays to be read “blind” by three judges from the Rotary Club. Please **TYPE** your essays. We understand your desire to explain your accomplishments, career goals, and current needs, but we ask that you avoid “wordiness” and be as direct as possible. Be sure to include the requested information for each essay. Each of the four essays is weighted equally. Grammar and spelling may influence a judge’s perception of you, so please pay attention to those areas as well. If you are a previous Enfield Rotary Scholarship winner, please write new essays for consideration, updating information from the past year.

EXTRA CURRICULAR— On this page, please detail your extra-curricular activities now and in the past—political, cultural, athletic, social, youth, volunteer and other activities. Describe leadership positions. Report significant events that shaped your life and career choices.

FINANCIAL NEED—Please provide a detailed statement of your financial need, including costs for tuition, room and board. Also please provide a detailed list of any new or existing scholarships by dollar amount that will aid you in the upcoming year, whether paid to you or the school.

SELF-HELP— Do not duplicate the section on financial need. What are you doing to help pay for your education now and in the past? Describe jobs and other work experience and any college work-study programs. Have you taken out loans and have you failed to qualify for loans?

STATEMENT—If I receive an Enfield Rotary Memorial Scholarship, I agree:
