## Monroeville Rotary Club

Monroeville Rotary is a group of business and community leaders – professionals that meet weekly. Meetings are held weekly so the members have consistency of interaction, review plans for upcoming events, discuss the operations of our Club, share information and fellowship, and of course have some fun!

Our Monroeville Club is one of the most active in the Pittsburgh area. We have about 75 Members and there are three to four major fundraisers held each year to raise money. Working together we raise over \$70,000 every year to support various local and international charities to help those in need. In addition, many of our members volunteer to help local charities – working in a food pantry, ringing bells in support of the Salvation Army, etc. Our Club led an effort and recently completed a project in Kenya to supply clean water to a community.

Our Members have financial obligations to the Club. There are yearly dues of \$160, weekly luncheon cost of \$14, 50/50 drawings, weekly polio eradication contribution, donations to the Rotary Foundation, participation in Club social events and fund raising activities you wish to attend throughout the year. Our Members budget about \$900 per year.
