Last week's program

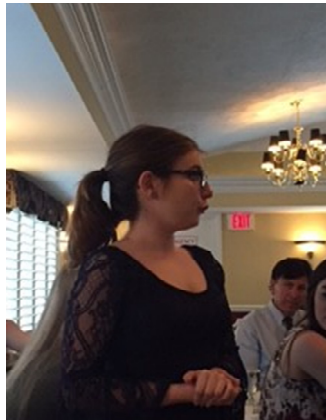
