Adalene “Nene” Spivy has led the Children’s Science Center since 2010. Under her leadership, annual visitation has grown from 3,500 to 70,000 visitors, serving children, families, and educators through community outreach programs and the Center’s first operating site at Fair Oaks Mall, which opened in 2015. Nene oversees all aspects of the Center’s operations and leads the effort to build a future, full-scale, world-class science center on donated land in Dulles, Virginia.

Nene brings a diverse range of experience, including systems and process engineering, new product development, and general management for technology businesses; fundraising, advocacy, strategic planning, volunteer management, and board development for nonprofits. She holds a BS in Industrial Engineering from Virginia Tech and an MBA from the University of

Virginia Darden School of Business.
