# Chuck Reavis, My Time with the FAA in Leesburg, VA

Chuck Reavis has been an active member of the Rotary Club of Leesburg since July 2009. He has served the club in several capacities, including Club President in 2014. Chuck's professional career has been predominantly in aviation, with an emphasis on national and international, civil and military, and air traffic control. Following five years in the US Air Force as a radio intercept operator (CW and foreign voice), Chuck joined the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) as an Air Traffic Controller. Progressing into senior ATC positions, he was selected as Air Traffic Manager of the Chicago

O'Hare Tower and Approach Control, Honolulu Tower and Approach Control, and the Washington Air Route Control Center in Leesburg (on two occasions). He managed several key FAA headquarters management positions. Following retirement from the federal government, Chuck joined Booz Allen Hamilton, facilitating programs in the field of Aviation Safety.
