Laura Christiansen, Curator Balch Library Pictures from Leesburg's Past



Laura Christiansen is the Curator of Manuscripts and Archives at the Thomas Balch Library in Leesburg, VA. She oversees collections management, processing, access, and outreach for manuscripts, archives, artifacts, and audio-visual collections, as well as for the records of the Town of Leesburg. Laura holds a B.A. in History and Art History from Berry College, an M.A. in Public History, and an M.L.I. S. from the University of South Carolina. She has previously served as Dickson

Librarian at the Chrysler Museum of Art and as Director of the Clarke County Historical Association. A central goal throughout Laura's career in archives, libraries, and museums has been to unite people and collections through access, long-term preservation, and collaboration to achieve shared goals.

Club Assembly





Members of the club came together to discuss the state of our club and future goals. Club treasurer Matt Burns provided a report from 2017 to the present showing income and overhead. It was pointed out that River Creek requires a minimum of 33 meals per meeting. Currently, members are charged less than the actual cost leaving a deficit.

Judge Horne gave an overview of the Perry Winston Scholarship Fund. The fund was started in 2004 with a gift of \$100,000. It is up to \$600,000, supported by individual donations and our annual fundraiser. The amount and number of scholarships to be awarded in the future was discussed.

Phil Rusciolelli reviewed Rotary's rules for child protection as required by our charter.
