These scholarships will be paid directly to the awardee for continuing education or for specific purchases of equipment, tools, computers, software programs, licensing or lab fees or other similar need.

CRITERIA to be eligible to a MATA Scholarship:

- Be a graduating senior from Loudoun County High School, Tuscarora High School or Heritage High School.
- Be enrolled in a MATA program.
- Demonstrate a financial need.
- Submit a completed application (see back) for instructions.
- Include a recommendation letter from you main MATA teacher

Please hand in your completed application and a recommendation letter to the scholarship committee of the Academies of Loudoun by the application deadline.

Application Deadline: April 12, 2024, 5:00 p.m.
