Gerald Goodman's appointment as Executive Director of the Accenture Match Play marks his return to the PGA TOUR. This 20-plus-year veteran of the golf industry began his career with the PGA TOUR in 1989 as a marketing manager. Most recently, he was tournament director of PGA TOUR events held at Innisbrook Resort and Golf Club in the Tampa/St Petersburg, Florida area from 1995-2010. Under his leadership, the Tournament grew to one of the top events on the PGA TOUR Florida Swing and has raised more than \$27 million for charities since 1977.

Goodman, a native of Blountstown, Florida, is known for his enthusiasm and attention to detail. Prior to his career in golf, he was a football coach at various universities including Mississippi State, Louisville and Southern Mississippi. He is a graduate of North Alabama where he was a starting quarterback on the football team.

His three grandchildren call him "Coach." He is married to the former Susan Tamme.

Gerald will speak to the Rotary Club of Tucson on the new changes in the 2012 world Golf Championship Accenture Match Play. He will show a four minute DVD showing some of the great highlights of last year's event as well as other winners on the PGA TOUR. He will close with an inside look at how the PGA TOUR is different than any other professional sport.
