## Food: The Connection with Health, Culture & The Environment

JP Jones III (Ph.D. Ohio State University) is a Professor of Geography and Development and Dean of the College of Social and Behavioral Sciences at the University of Arizona.

Since Jones was appointed Dean of the UA's College of Social and Behavioral Sciences in 2010, he has led the twenty-three schools, departments, research units, and outreach centers in the college with keen attention to the importance of innovation and diversity in examining the human experience. SBS - "The People College" - explores human histories, ideas, communities, cultures, and relationships as part of the process of discovery, with strategic priorities around health, environment, technology, and global impact and regional roots.

A champion of interdisciplinary education, Jones has helped support several new undergraduate and graduate programs in the areas of International Security, Criminal Justice Studies, Environmental Studies, Geographical Information Systems Technology, e-Society, Global Studies, Development Practice, Care, Health and Society, and Sports and Society – to better prepare students for the changing futures that await them, and to better serve the communities in which they will work and live.

Dr. Jones holds key service roles at the University of Arizona, including Chair of the Deans + Development Committee, and member of the UA-UA Foundation Relations Committee, Strategic Planning and Budget Committee, and University Development

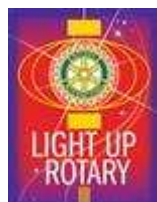

There are still a couple positions needed to be filled for the District Conference in September as follows:

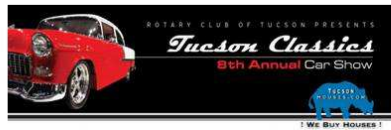
