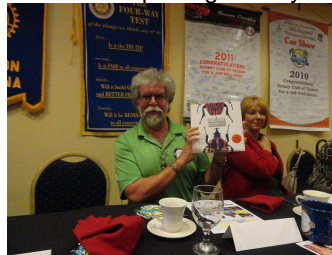
Tucson Rotary!
