- \$2000

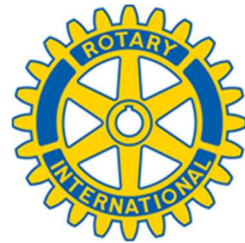
Eligibility:

- Graduating senior from local high school or home school.
- Applicants must reside in Green Valley/Sahuarita area
- Special consideration will be given to financial need.

Evaluation Process:

1. Applications must be completed and returned to the Valle Verde Rotary Club Scholarship Committee by **Friday, April 08, 2022**.
2. The following criteria will be used in the evaluation process:
 - a. Green Valley/Sahuarita resident
 - b. Graduating Senior
 - c. Completed application
 - d. High school academic record
 - e. Extracurricular including clubs, sports, and volunteer activities
 - f. Essay questions
 - g. Letters of Recommendation (limit 3)
 - h. Personal interview if necessary
 - i. Financial need

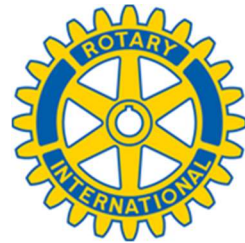

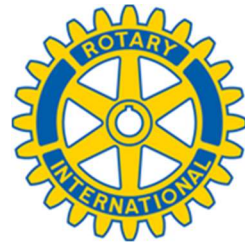
