REBUILDING TOGETHER

Dave Downing took great pleasure in introducing his daughter, Terry Gallo. Terry told us about the *Rebuilding Today Affiliate Network*, a group that seeks to transform the lives of low income homeowners by improving the safety and health of their homes.

Rebuilding Today consists of a group of 160 affiliates in the US which, in 2015, completed work on some 8,890 homes and non-profits across the nation. With the help of 105,000 volunteers, over 500,000 community members were served.

Since its establishment in 1991, *Rebuilding Today Silicon Valley (RTSV)*, the local affiliate, has reno-

vated over 3,000 homes and community facilities. They currently serve some 367 homes per year.

Some of the criteria used to select homes to rebuild:

- Owner-occupied for at least one year
- Income less than 80% AMI. Average household income is \$26,203.
- Preference given to elderly and disabled

- Average age is 70
- Seniors make up 79%
- Seniors and/or disabled 90%
- Veterans 19%
- Minors 12%

"Rebuilding Days" include tasks for both skilled and unskilled workers. Clients can remain in their homes, and are approved on a case-by-case basis.

Some recent Rebuilding Day projects are:

A "Critical Program" addresses problems such as water heater, roof, furnace, emergency electrical, and emergency plumbing.

"Safe at Home" projects look at bathroom and shower safety, safety railings and entries, ramps and electric lifts, fire safety and green upgrades, usually some sort of deferred maintenance.

Seven full-time people and many, many volunteers are busy making life better for others.
