DECADES OF SUNNY MORNINGS

Tony James introduced Lissa Chrysler, a longtime co-emcee of the KBAY Morning Show. Lissa demonstrated a super-great attitude as she told us of some four decades of summer

mornings on the show. We managed to catch a photo of her that shows the delight she had in serving the public all those years.

Last December the Mercury
News told us that South
Bay radio listeners and the
community as a whole lost
two of its favorite voices
when Sam Van
Zandt and Lissa
Kreisler wrapped up their
morning show on KBAY-FM
for the last time after
12 years as a team.

Van Zandt, who is 70 years old, decided earlier this year to retire after a 52-year career because of health reasons. But Kreisler's departure wasn't planned. KBAY management informed her December 7 that she wouldn't be staying on with the station, either, rather unceremoniously ending her 29-year tenure there. While conceding working alongside Van Zandt has been "magic" that would be difficult to rep-

licate, she says she's not ready to retire.

"I'm not going anywhere," Kreisler said. "I'm still part of the community here — I hope."

Friday morning at the 94.5-FM studio was a bittersweet one, with fan after fan calling in to say goodbye — and Sam and Lissa consoling the callers as much as they were consoling the hosts. KRTY morning hosts Gary Scott Thomas and Julie Stevens called in, as did KDFC's Hoyt Smith. San Jose Mayor Sam Liccardo stopped by with a bouquet of tulips Kreisler and a proclamation declaring December 2016, as "Sam & Lissa in

the Morning Show Day." Off the air, there were a few tears between breaks, but on the air there were a lot of laughs and memories being shared.

"This is a tough day for everyone," KBAY General Manager **John Levitt** said. "But I've been saying to everyone that these guys are bigger than this station."

Both Van Zandt and Kreisler have been mainstays at nonprofit events throughout the years, whether acting as emcess — with those radio voices, they're perfect choices — or helping raise money or bring in donations. Last Saturday, they sat under a yellow, rain-soaked canopy for their annual *Stuff the Bus* drive for *Toys for Tots*. Here's everything you need to know about them: They both knew it was their last broadcast at the park, but didn't let on and kept the focus on the kids who would benefit.

The list of nonprofits and community organizations they've helped is too long to list, but a few of their favorites include JW House, Sunday Friends, Special Olympics, Cancer Care-Point, Hunger at Home and the All the Way Home campaign to support homeless veterans.
