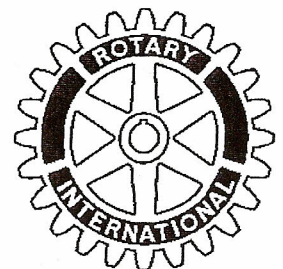

Charean Williams Cowboys and the NFL

Charean Williams has covered the NFL for 21 seasons, including the past 15 for the Fort Worth Star-Telegram. She appears regularly on Fox Sports One. She previously was a regular on ESPN2's First Take morning show. In 2008, she served as an analyst for ESPN's second-day NFL Draft coverage.

Charean became the first woman to serve as a selector for the Pro Football Hall of Fame in 2006 and also was the first female president of the Pro Football Writers of America. She has covered 20 Super Bowls and six Olympic Games.

Charean is a 1986 graduate of Texas A&M and began her career on a three-person sports staff in Orange, Texas. She stayed there eight months, covering high schools, working the desk and doing everything you do at a small town local paper. Charean then joined the Bryan-College Station Eagle where she covered the A&M Consolidated High School and Texas A&M beats.

After six years in Bryan-College Station, Charean was hired by the Orlando Sentinel to cover NASCAR. After a little over a year in that beat, she was promoted to cover the Tampa Bay Buccaneers and the NFL. Charean worked for the Sentinel six years, living in Daytona Beach and then in Tampa.
