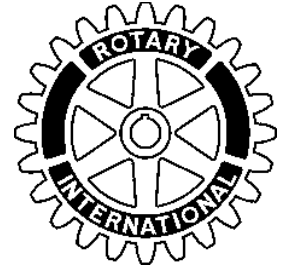

Silence Isn't Golden: How to Make the Most of Your Hearing

Dr. Paula Land is Board Certified in Audiology, holds the Certificate of Clinical Competence from the American Speech Language and Hearing Association, and is a Fellow in the American Academy of Audiology and the Tinnitus Practitioners' Association. A former lieutenant in the U. S. Marine Corps, Paula earned a Master of Science degree in Communication Disorders - Audiology from the University of Texas at Dallas and a doctorate in audiology from the University of Florida.

Paula's path to becoming one of Dallas/Fort Worth's leading audiologists began when her son contracted meningitis when he was two. Fortunately, he came through the ordeal safe and sound, but accepting the possibility that he could lose some or all of his hearing as a result of the infection was enough to spur Paula's interest in treating deafness and hearing loss as a career.

Dr. Land practiced in medical diagnostic settings for several years, then opened the Hearing and Tinnitus Center of Dallas Fort Worth in 2009. Her Irving-based clinic provides complete hearing health care, including comprehensive audiological and tinnitus evaluations and services for adults and seniors. Dr. Land is certified in tinnitus management and has served as an off-site clinical supervisor for the University of North Texas' Department of Speech and Hearing and the Doctor of Audiology Program at the University of Texas at Dallas.

"America the Beautiful"

The words of this song came from a poem of the same title by Katharine Lee Bates (1859 -1929). She wrote the poem in 1893 and then revised it twice; first in 1904 and then in 1913.

The melody of the song was written in 1882 by composer and organist Samuel Augustus Ward (1847-1903) and was originally titled "Materna." The lyrics combined with the melody was first published in 1910. This tune, which is now greatly associated with "America the Beautiful," wasn't used until 1910.
