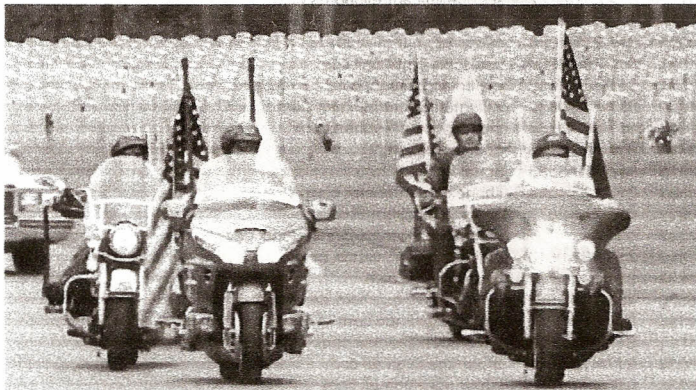

Quick Super Bowl Facts

This is the first Super Bowl to be played outdoors in a cold weather environment.

The trophy is made by high-end jeweler Tiffany & Co and stands almost 21 inches tall and weighs 107 ounces. It is worth more than \$25,000.

Tickets for the inaugural Super Bowl were sold for \$6 but the price increases have outpaced inflation and the face value for tickets this year range between \$500 and \$2,600. On the secondary market, they changing hands for an average of between 3 to 4 times the value.

Players' share: Winning team gets \$92,000 per player, losing team gets \$46,000 per player.

The Pittsburgh Steelers hold the record for the most Super Bowl titles, with six. The San Francisco 49ers and Dallas Cowboys are tied for second with five each.

This years broadcaster is charging advertisers an estimated \$4 million for 30-second spots.
