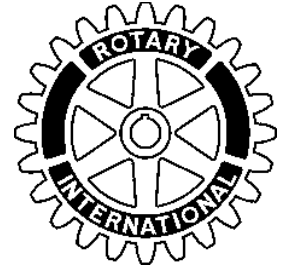

Russell Husted Fly Fishing in North Texas

Russell Husted is President of the new Texas Council of the International Federation of Fly Fishers and Past President of the Fort Worth Fly Fishers. He especially loves fishing creeks and rivers. If there is moving water to fish, he will try it out. In Texas he fishes the Brazos and Nolan rivers. Summers find him fishing in Colorado, and fall takes him to Arkansas. His favorite fishing is for sand bass in spring, but he also targets them in tailraces below dams year round. Russell has been fly-fishing for 10 years and also enjoys fly-tying. He posts frequently on fishing forums and websites and describes his major addiction as fly-fishing and his major health problem as trout burn.

The Fort Worth Fly Fishers became an active club in 1985, and have been promoting the sport of fly fishing, ever since. 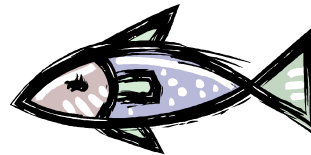
