Joe Ferrell The State of Literacy In Texas

Joe Ferrell is retired as owner and president of Safeguard Retirement Planning, Inc. in Arlington, TX. Joe spent 11 years in the retirement planning business and retired at the end of 2011.

As a graduate of Baylor University in Waco, Texas, Joe holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Biology and Education. He began his professional career as a high school biology teacher. Later, Joe developed a unique brain therapy learning system and started an educational software company named Creative Education Institute in Waco, Texas.

After selling the company, Joe worked with Hughes Training Inc., a division of Hughes Aircraft in Arlington as a Senior Scientist in the Technology Office.
