Judge Mary Tom Curnutt What does a Justice of the Peace do?

Judge Mary Tom Curnutt took the bench as the Precinct 2 Justice of the Peace in May, 2013, to fill the remaining term of retiring Judge Linda Bierman Davis through the end of 2014. After winning the Republican primary election in March, she is unopposed in the November general election and will serve as our Justice of the Peace in downtown Arlington for at least four more years.

The Precinct-2 JP Court in Arlington is a particularly busy court, 15,000 to 20,000 cases each year, consistently handling more civil lawsuits than any other court in Tarrant County and most every other county in Texas. In addition to civil cases, JP2 Court also handles truancy for the Arlington Independent School District, eviction lawsuits, TXDPS license suspension and revocation hearings, and a plethora of other types of cases. The job of JP requires the ability to fairly, respectfully and objectively decide and resolve hundreds of disputes each month.

Mary Tom was raised in Arlington and educated in Arlington ISD. After graduation *Magna Cum Laude* from Arlington High School, Mary Tom went west to TCU and earned a BBA in Business. She married her high school sweetheart, Kelly Curnutt, and then worked for Software Spectrum for ten years in Dallas. As Sales Director, she led her team to \$20 million/year in sales and opened an international branch in Dublin, Ireland.

After her success in the business world, Mary Tom and Kelly moved back to Arlington to start and raise their family. While the Curnutts had two natural born sons, they were also blessed with several "bonus boys" that kept the house hopping with testosterone. They have been laughingly known to say that raising a bunch of boys requires a referee's whistle, a 2"x4", and a lot of love.
