Try to list a contact person and phone number for each potential advertiser, if this is not already provided, even if you don't make a sale, so we will have a better chance next year. Also, please try to put a name in the greeting data fields. When we send the bill/thank you letter, we really want to personalize it as much as possible. Also indicate if this potential advertiser should be removed from the contact list altogether.

We have also included an extra blank control sheet in the event that you decide to call on someone extra.

If you have a potential advertiser you don't think you should call on, feel free to swap with someone. Please note the change in rotarian on your control sheet. We will then know to look to someone else for the information on that advertiser. If you can't swap and don't think you should call on a advertiser, please let us know. We will try to arrange to get the call made by another rotarian.

If you can find the time to call on the potential advertisers assigned to you, that extra effort will guarantee a successful Radio Day. If you find you are unable to make your assigned phone calls, please let me know so that your calls will be assigned to someone else.
