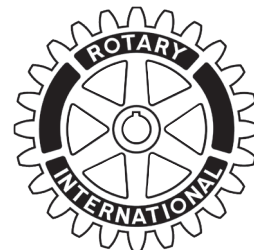

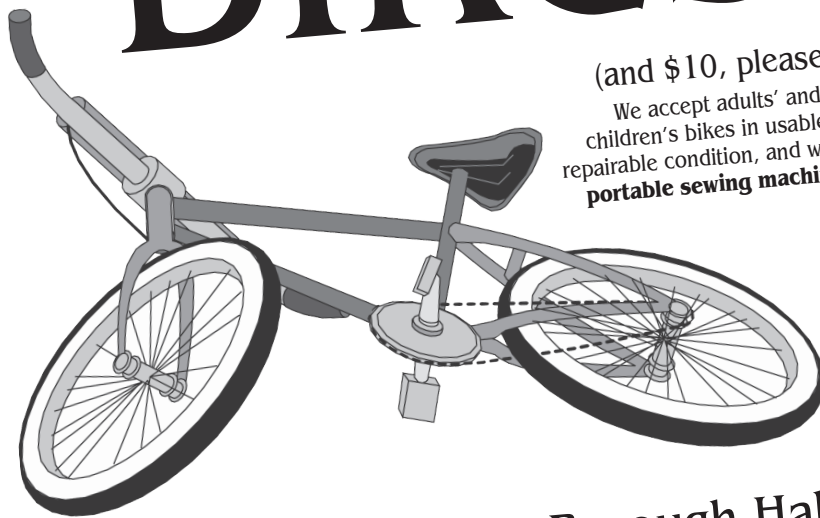

Every year, Americans buy about 18 million new bicycles and discard millions of old ones, leaving many of them unused in basements, sheds, and garages. Meanwhile, people in poverty in developing third-world countries need cheap, nonpolluting transportation to get to jobs, deliver goods to market, provide services to customers, and get to schools and community medical centers.



Pedals for Progress rescues repairable bikes destined for America's landfills and sends more than 10,000 of them annually to Latin America, Africa, and the Pacific Islands, where they are reconditioned and put to productive use.

It costs \$40 to collect, process, ship, rebuild, and distribute each bicycle. A **tax-deductible donation of \$10 per bicycle is requested to help cover shipping costs.**
